Birgit Coath makes skillful use of light and dark, adding drama to her soulful images, depicting scenes of Tibet, Mexico and the West Coast.

Nancy Dean's fascination with reflective surfaces and architectural forms shows in her land-and cityscapes, which are usually large and dramatic.

Gabrielle Greig started her formal art training in Vienna, Austria, and works predominantly in acrylics, depicting florals, foreign and local landscapes and abstracts in bold colors with an impressionistic flair. In her other style, “intriguing metallics”, the viewer is drawn to rich textures and sculpted finishes in bronze and gold tones.

A passion for pattern is clearly evident in **Linda Bell's** enchanting and often playful collages. Her artwork is stunning at first glance, with a riot of pattern and color. And closer inspection invariably creates conversation as one is drawn into the detail.

All four artists are members of the South Delta Artists' Guild as well as Active members of the Federation of Canadian Artists, Gabrielle Greig is also a member of New West Artists and the Fraser Valley Artists.

This is a show that is worth the outing to the pastoral setting of Tsawwassen. The Longhouse Gallery has plenty of free parking and is open 11 am to 4 pm daily. Live guitar music will be featured at the opening celebration on Feb 19th from 1:30-3:30. You will not be disappointed.
